

EVALUATION report, Barcelona – third meeting in MOBYS project by OHP, Poland

In May (19th – 21st) the third partners meeting in MOBYS project (sponsored by Socrates Grundtvig 2 programme) took place. Meeting was organized in Barcelona in Spain by Spanish partner PROBENS. Its main focus were: approving a questionnaire form (now we have a final version), evaluation of what we have done so far, establishing a time-table for next months, and discussion about final report from first year of our project.

Workshop in Barcelona was the biggest staff meeting in MOBYS project. From Poland came five staff members (it was first meeting with project partners for Mr Józef Wojtas, who is a General Manager of the Silesian OHP) and one student of OHP in Jaworzno. Meeting in Barcelona began with our common dinner on Thursday and after it we started project working. In PROBENS office we were shown a short presentation about way of work the Brafa association, with whom the Spanish partner is cooperating in Barcelona. All partners received documentation: some magazines and brochures published by Brafa.



Spanish partner proposed us a fanny way of doing an evaluation of our meeting. The idea was: to write our opinion for each work event (with plus and minus mark) on the coloured piece of paper and put them on walls. All we enjoyed of doing such evaluation.



Of course, there were much more pluses but some minus marks were given too. We feel a little bit disappointed because we couldn't know the Spanish learners and PROBENS' way of work.

The working time was well arranged by PROBENS. Thanks to two interpreters (of English and German) arranged during work hours, there were no languages barriers. We thank the Spanish partner for mutual dinner in a restaurant where we could taste a local meal – delicious Paella.

All project partners made common decision about: the time of conducting a survey using a questionnaire, the time-table for meeting in Czech Republic, dates for Polish meeting, a deadline for evaluation the Spanish meeting and final reports of our project, which each partner should prepare for their National Agencies. Deadline for all of us is at the end of September.

Because the Polish partner had some free time before and after the workshop, they could visit and get to know the history of Barcelona. Polish group saw a few interesting places in town: Anella Olimpica (“Olympic Ring”), Güell Park – one of Gaudi’s best known works, Casa Mila and Casa Batllo Arc de Triomf, Rambla de Canaletes - the most lively part of Barcelona and finally the most well-know church in this town – Sagrada Familia.
